During the 1960-1962 biennium, the Military Code of Washington was revised by the State of Washington to provide for the separation of the Washington National Guard into Army, and Air Divisions within the Headquarters. This provided for an Assistant Adjutant General, Army and an Assistant Adjutant General, Air. Concurrently with the activation of the Air Division, Brigadier General Lyle E. Buchanan was appointed Assistant Adjutant General, Army. Colonel Robert F. King, Air National Guard, was appointed Assistant Adjutant General, Air. At this time the approximate strength of the Air National Guard of Washington was 170 officers and 1,291 enlisted men.
