There were two military support units at McCook during 1918. The 246th Aero Squadron, previously mentioned, had arrived in November 1917. On January 9, 1918, it was redesignated the 807th Aero Squadron. On July 1, 1918, the 881st Aero Squadron was organized at McCook.

On July 12th, the squadrons were further designated as Squadron A (807th) and Squadron B (881st). On August 1, 1918, the two squadrons were merged into "Detachment No. 10, A.S.A.P."
