

702 MUNITIONS SUPPORT SQUADRON



MISSION

The 702 Munitions Support Squadron is a Geographically Separated Unit responsible for receipt, storage, maintenance and control of US war reserve munitions in support of the German Air Force. The squadron directly supports NATO and its strike mission.

The 702 MUNSS has approximately 139 active duty military, one non-appropriated funds civilian, and two local national employees. The military members are composed of 24 separate Air Force Specialty Codes. The unit supports over 350 family members and a few retirees in the local area. They are responsible for ownership, custody, maintenance, and release of a protection level 1 stockpile with an annual budget of \$200K.

The 702 MUNSS is divided into 5 flights consisting of the maintenance, operations, communications, custody and mission support.

On a disc Azure, fimbriated Or, a sword point to chief Argent between two laurel branches arcing to sword Vert, the sword gripped by two stylized eagles addorsed and wings elevated Sable, eyed and clawed of the like, fimbriated and beaked of the second, head of the third, upon a demi-globe issuant from base of the fourth, gridlined Black, all within a narrow border Black. Attached above the disc, a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "PARTNERS IN PEACE" in Black letters. Attached below the disc, a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "702 MUNSS" in Black letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The eagle symbolizes the soaring power and freedom of NATO. The sword represents responsibility. The sword being grasped simultaneously by the two eagles demonstrates how the task of mutual protection must be shared. The globe represents the worldwide mission of the unit. The motto, "Partners in Peace," emphasizes the ultimate goal.
