OPERATIONS

1st Air Division was allotted to the Seventh Corps Area. Headquarters initiated in Nov 1924 at Omaha, NE. Inactivated on 28 Nov 1928 and withdrawn from the Seventh Corps Area. Withdrawn from the Organized Reserve on 8 May 1929, allotted to the Regular Army, and further allotted to the Eighth Corps Area. Kelly Field, TX, designated as headquarters on reorganization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Designated mobilization training station was the Air Corps Training Center, Kelly Field.
